


Morphology of Gram positive



Corynebacterium diphtheriae

- Irregular staining
- Gram positive bacilli
- Non-spore forming
- Nonmotile
- Pleomorphic
- Toxigenic, nontoxigenic

Diphtheria toxin

- Exotoxin
- Consist of active A domain, binding B domain
- Toxin inhibits protein synthesis in all cells, including myocardial, renal, peripheral nerve cells, resulting in myocarditis, acute tubular necrosis, and delayed peripheral nerve conduction.
- Endocarditis can be caused by nontoxigenic strain
