


At a tertiary care hospital

- A one year old boy was admitted because of high grade fever & dehydration for one day.
 Imp. URI with dehydration.
- 3 days after admission he had progressive non productive cough and developed generalized erythrematous MP rash
- PE: bilateral conjunctival injection, Koplik's spot +


Measles?

- Air borne transmission
- At general Pediatric ward, There were ten Children admitted. (6 mo-2 yr)
- Seven of those got MMR vaccination at 9 months years old. → Observe



• 2 children who receipted MMR vaccine develop fever with rash 3 days later.





Vaccine failure?

 1st dose MMR vaccine → efficacy 95% in children > 12 months old

 seroconversion rates after MMR immunization are significantly lower in children immunized before the first birthday than are seroconversion rates in children

immunized after the first birthday.
